Hobby Houston Federal Inspection Services (FIS) Terminal Project consist of a two-level, 280,000-square-foot terminal with ticket counter, six security lanes, five arrival and departure gates, demolition of the existing Badge and Administrative facility, relocation of several offices and shops to an existing facility, relocation
